How to connect a UPS battery to a host?

F. Before connecting the battery cables from the battery cabinet to the host, measure the battery voltage with a multimeter, which should be 103.36V, and check if the positive and negative leads are correctly connected. If there is a battery box, connect the batteries in series and link them to the host as required. 2. UPS Battery Wiring Example A.

Route the battery temperature sensor cables through the conduit box to the UPS.
Disconnect the cables from J2-1 and J2-2 and connect the battery temperature sensor.
